



ESSENTIAL *Piano care* GUIDE

1 *Regular cleaning*

- **Dusting:** dust the exterior and keys with a soft, dry cloth regularly
- **Cleaning Keys:** use a slightly damp cloth to clean keys. Avoid excess moisture.
- **Avoid Harsh Chemicals:** do not use alcohol or harsh cleaners

Ideal Environment **2**

- **Humidity:** maintain humidity levels between 42-50% to prevent wood damage
- **Temperature:** keep piano away from direct sunlight, drafts and heat sources
- **Placement:** position your piano against an inner wall for more stable temperature and humidity

3 *Tuning and Maintenance*

- **Regular Tuning:** have your piano tuned at least twice a year by a professional
- **Professional Inspection:** schedule annual check-ups with a piano technician to ensure all parts are in good condition

Playing Care **4**

- **Clean Hands:** always wash your hands before playing
- **Gentle Touch:** avoid banging the keys with excessive strength, and close the lid gently after use

5 *Moving Your Piano*

- **Professional Movers:** always hire professional piano movers to relocate your instrument
- **Proper Support:** ensure the piano is supported properly during the move to avoid damage

Long-Term Storage **6**

- **Climate Control:** store in a climate-controlled environment
- **Covering:** use a piano cover to protect from dust and debris

7 *Additional Tips*

- **Avoid Items on Top:** do not place heavy or liquid items on top of the piano
- **Check Pedals:** ensure pedals are functioning correctly; adjust if necessary
- **Monitor Sound:** pay attention to changes in sound that may indicate a need for tuning or repair
